The 2021 Championship and Off Road Series: We discussed next year's championships at Monday's committee meeting and the consensus was that it too early to make a decision. Rest assured that when the mists clear we will reach out to the membership before pressing ahead. However, it remains our intention where possible to use races from the 2020 Championship list in next year's championship, especially where we know members have already shelled out their hard earned dosh on entry fees.

Dorset Road Race League 2021: You may be interested in the following statement from the DRRL Committee:

"As you will know at the meeting in April of this year it was decided to cancel to 2020 series and that all the races to be carried over to 2021. However, it is now apparent that, due to the COVID restrictions lasting longer than anticipated, this will not be possible. Currently UKA regulations are requiring extra first aid, no mass starts and a change of timing requirements. Many races scheduled for 2021 have either been cancelled or put "on hold" pending further COVID developments in 2021.

A virtual Zoom meeting was held on the 5th Oct to discuss the 2021 League. The committee felt that, at this stage, it was not possible to publish a list of League races for 2021. All Clubs present wanted to see some form of competition for next year. Some Clubs suggested a number of "Virtual" League races whilst others thought a League start in May/June next year to include races that Clubs might find it possible to stage in the later part of 2021. It was decided to hold a further meeting in November and in the meantime obtain feedback from race organisers, participants and the public from local road races that have taken place under the current COVID restrictions."

Facebook: Since the Summer we have been operating with just the 'open' Facebook group and all seems to going well. It is perhaps worth noting that the open group does attract interest from prospective new members. Therefore, whilst we appreciate some of you may miss the opportunity to banter away in the 'closed' Facebook group, our intention is to continue with just the open group.
